### ELIGIBILITY & REGULATIONS

1. Only film shot & produced in India by an Indian citizen between 1st September 2005 and 31st January 2007 are eligible.
2. Diploma films/videos cannot be considered as Director's First film.
3. Each entry should be accompanied by a Non-Refundable Entry Fee of Rs. 1000/- from India. Fee may be paid either by Bank Pay Order / Demand Draft, in favour of CELLULOID CHAPTER, Payable at Jamshedpur
4. If the language of the film is other than English, it should be dubbed or sub-titled in English.
5. Selection of films for Competition will be made by a committee whose decision will be final. However, Festival Authorities reserve the right to accept or not to accept any film.
6. Sample DVD/VCD sent for selection purpose will be retained by the Festival Authorities.
7. Last date for receipt of entry form with sample VCD / DVD for selection in Competition will be 22/02/2008.
8. Transportation cost of VCDs / DVDs, etc. and all related documents, publicity materials from the Director's address to the Festival Office shall be borne by the applicant. Transportation cost of return of VCDs/DVDs will be borne by the Festival Authorities. Films will be returned within one month from closing of the festival subject to retention of the samples sent for selection and VCD/ DVD each of the Award winning film for the purpose of the Festival Archive. However, Photographs & Publicity Materials received along with the Entry will not be returned to the entrants.
9. **Accommodation** : Lodging & fooding for two days of Director's only.
10. **Award** : a) Best Documentary film - Rs. 10,000/- b) Best FICTION film - Rs. 10,000/- c) JURY Award (for Director) - Trophy
11. Insurance cost on films in transit from the sender's to the festival office and back will be borne by the applicant. The Festival Authorities are not responsible against technical damage, fire, destruction, loss, theft during the period between their arrival at the Festival Office and despatch from the Festival Office.
12. Prize money, trophy and certificate will be awarded to the director of the film.
13. The Festival Authorities will have the right to retain a copy of the Film to screen in different cities of India on non-commercial basis.
14. Entry Forms with incorrect / inadequate / illegible / ambiguous particulars will not be considered.
15. Films on DVD/VCD submitted for selection will be considered as final and no changes will be entertained after submission. It is the sole responsibility of the applicant to submit DVD/VCD without any physical / quality defects.
16. Decisions of the Festival Authorities regarding all matters not expressly provided for in these regulations or which require interpretation of the clauses mentioned above shall be final & binding on all parties.
